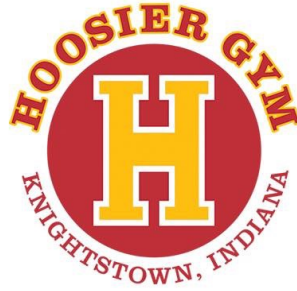

Tickets: Tickets will be sold at the door for \$10 by a ticket seller provided by the Hoosier Gym. Home team may assign an individual to assist in the ticket sales. The total number of tickets sold can not exceed 600. The revenue of sales will be split with the Gym and the Home Team 50/50.

Officials: The Hoosier Gym hires IHSAA officials to work the games. 3 Officials for Varsity and 2 Officials for Junior Varsity games. We only hire Officials with Tournament experience. Officials are paid \$80.00 each per official, per game. The Officials are paid out of gate receipts.

Home Team Responsibilities: Bring a Clock operator, PA (if desired), and designate a National Anthem singer or use the Gym's recorded version.

Fans: Home Team will sit in Sections A & B North side of gym and Visiting Team will sit in Sections C & D South side of gym. Direction signage will be placed on the ticket booth where you enter. No fans are allowed on the floor at any time (No Exceptions). If your game is part of a multiple game day, fans may enter the game 15 minutes following the fans exit from the previous game. Fans should not come to the Gym earlier than 30 minutes before the start of the game.

Player Introductions: All team members are introduced. They are to go to center court and face their fan section. This will allow parents to photograph their children on the court.

Cheerleaders: Because of limited sideline space Cheerleaders (if attending) must remain in front row of sections B & C. Cheerleaders will be allowed on the floor for: player introductions, half-time, and between quarters.

Balls: Spalding is the official ball of The Hoosier Gym. The Gym supplies balls for both teams for warm-up. Only Spalding balls may be used for pre-game. Schools should not bring warmup balls to the Gym. If the Home team wants a different make ball for the game, they must supply the game ball.

Concessions and Memorabilia: The Hoosier Gym will sell concessions. No outside food or drink is allowed by fans in the gym. The Hoosier Gym will sell Hoosier Gym Memorabilia. No outside sales of memorabilia is allowed.

Rent: The rental fee for the Gym is \$100 per game.

Locker Room Assignment: The Home Team has their choice of locker rooms. East Locker Room was used in movie Hoosiers. West Locker Room was not used in movie. On multiple game days special locker room rotation is necessary. A Gym volunteer will be assigned to assist the teams in this rotation.

Certificate of Liability Insurance: Each school must provide The Hoosier Gym with a Certificate of Liability Insurance one week prior to the game.
